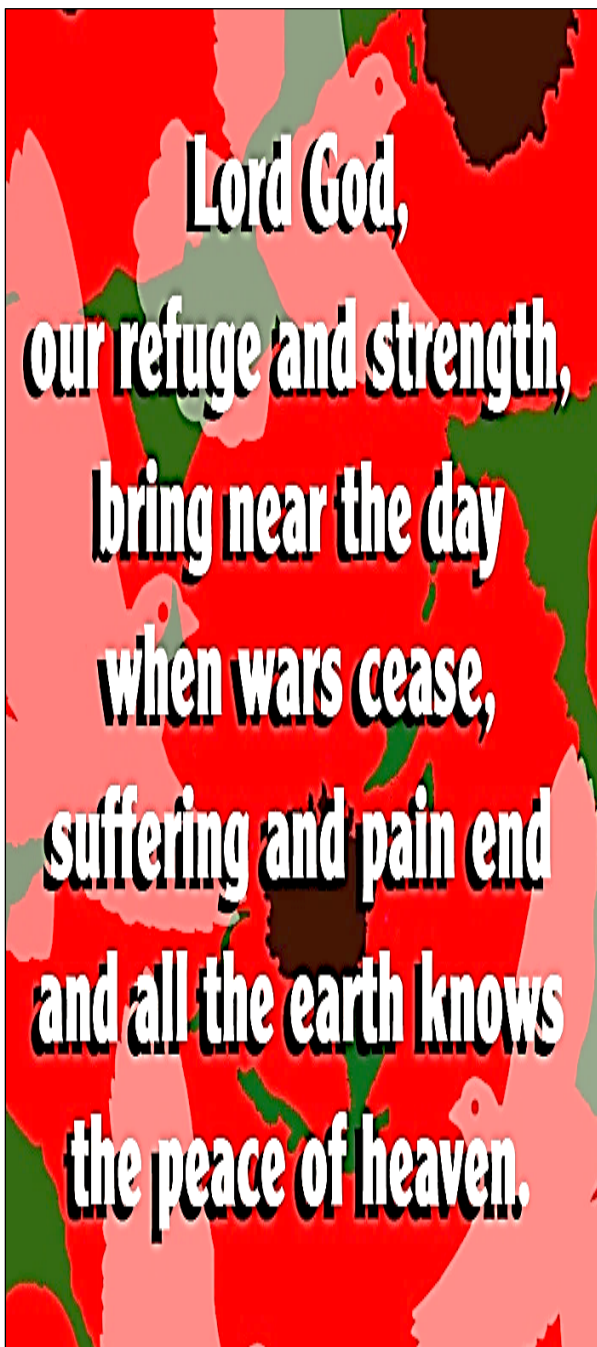

10.30 a.m. Communion Service.

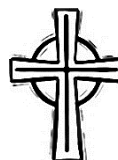
