GATEHOUSE – CHRISTIAN CHARITY FOR HOMELESS AND VULNERABLY HOUSED PEOPLE

Gatehouse was set up 40 years ago by the churches in and around Oxford, initially to provide a drop-in café for people who were sleeping on the streets, plus clothing and bedding for them. Nowadays it also supports individuals and families who are vulnerably housed, or in food poverty.

Homelessness can happen to anyone. It just takes one stroke of bad luck, relationship break-up, job loss, the landlord deciding to sell up. Many homeless people have spent their childhood in the care system, emotionally homeless. Gatehouse provides trained case-workers who offer practical advice and also counselling to address the issues that might underlie homelessness.

Once every six weeks it is Eynsham's turn to make donations. Members of all three churches bake cakes, make sandwiches, or give shop bought food. Anything that can be used in the café is welcome. Homemade food is special for the clients. You need to warn of any allergens, but this is easy and I can provide labels.

We also welcome clothes and shoes (especially men's). Only underwear has to be brand new. All other usable clean clothes are needed, especially coats, hats & gloves in winter. Also rucksacks, toiletries, bedding and washable sleeping bags (we can't take feather duvets). Volunteers deliver items to my house 15 Newland St <u>between 9 am -1 pm.</u> on 'our' Sunday. The Rotarians collect and deliver to Gatehouse.
